Since 2004 the Jack Petchey Foundation has donated

**over £120,000** to the Panathlon Challenge, which seeks to **inspire young disabled people** to use competitive sport and fair play as a means of social and personal development.

Panathlon has provided training courses, coaching grants, free equipment and mini 'Paralympic' style competitions for disabled young people in London, Kent, Essex and Merseyside since 1996.

Panathlon is the only organisation in England to offer young people with severe special needs the chance to compete in sport at both local and regional levels.

It is a **unique social opportunity** as well as a sporting one, allowing young people to meet outside of the school community, and providing opportunities both for friendship and heightened competition.
