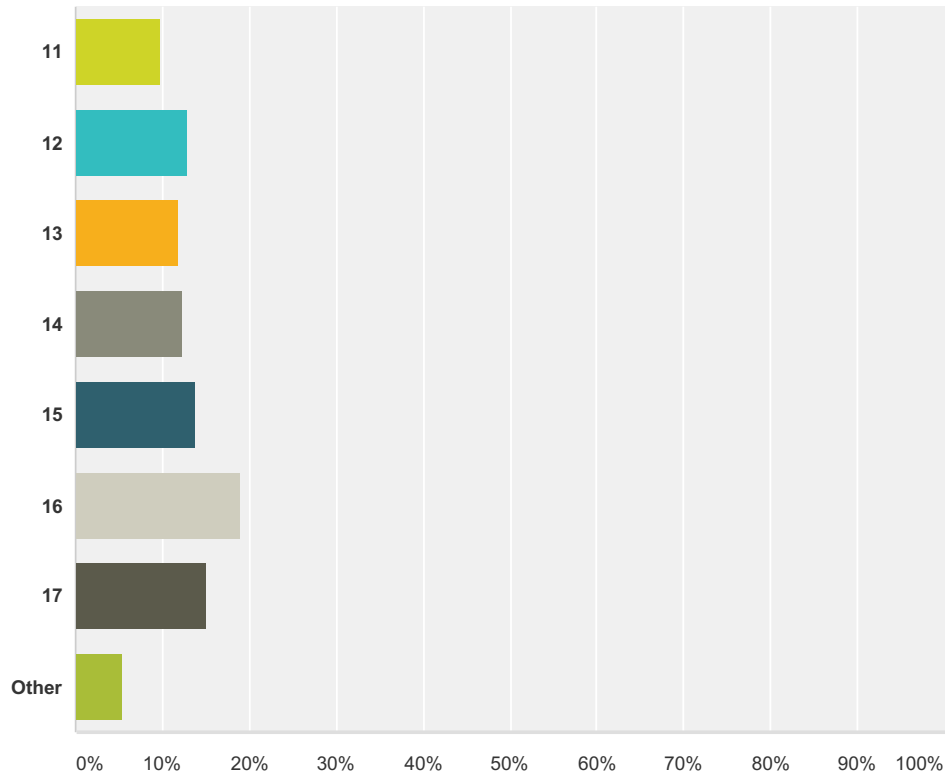


Q1 How old are you?

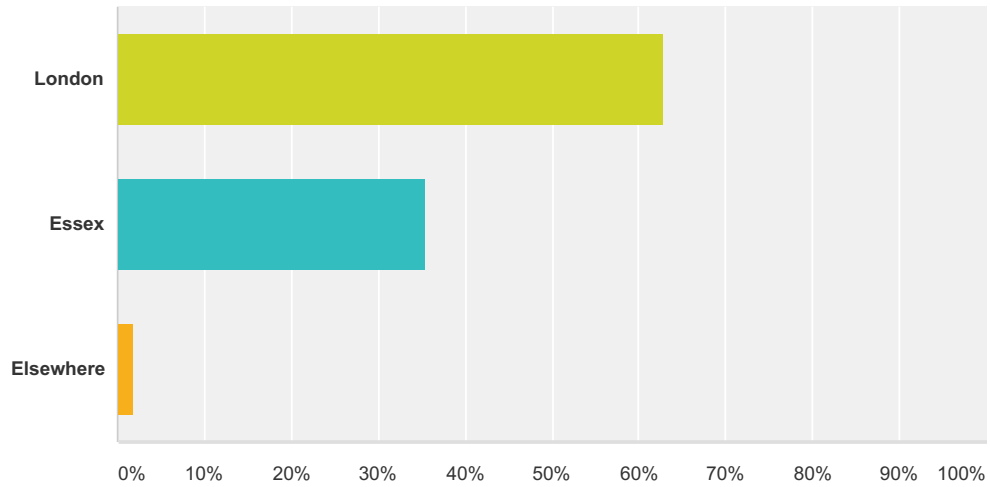

Q2 Where do you live?

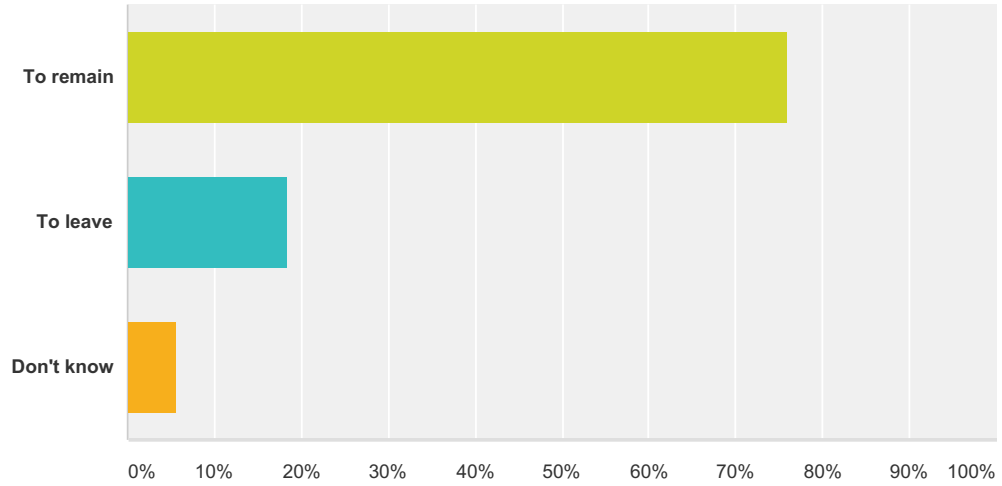

Q3 If you could have, how would you have voted in the referendum on Britain's membership of the European Union?

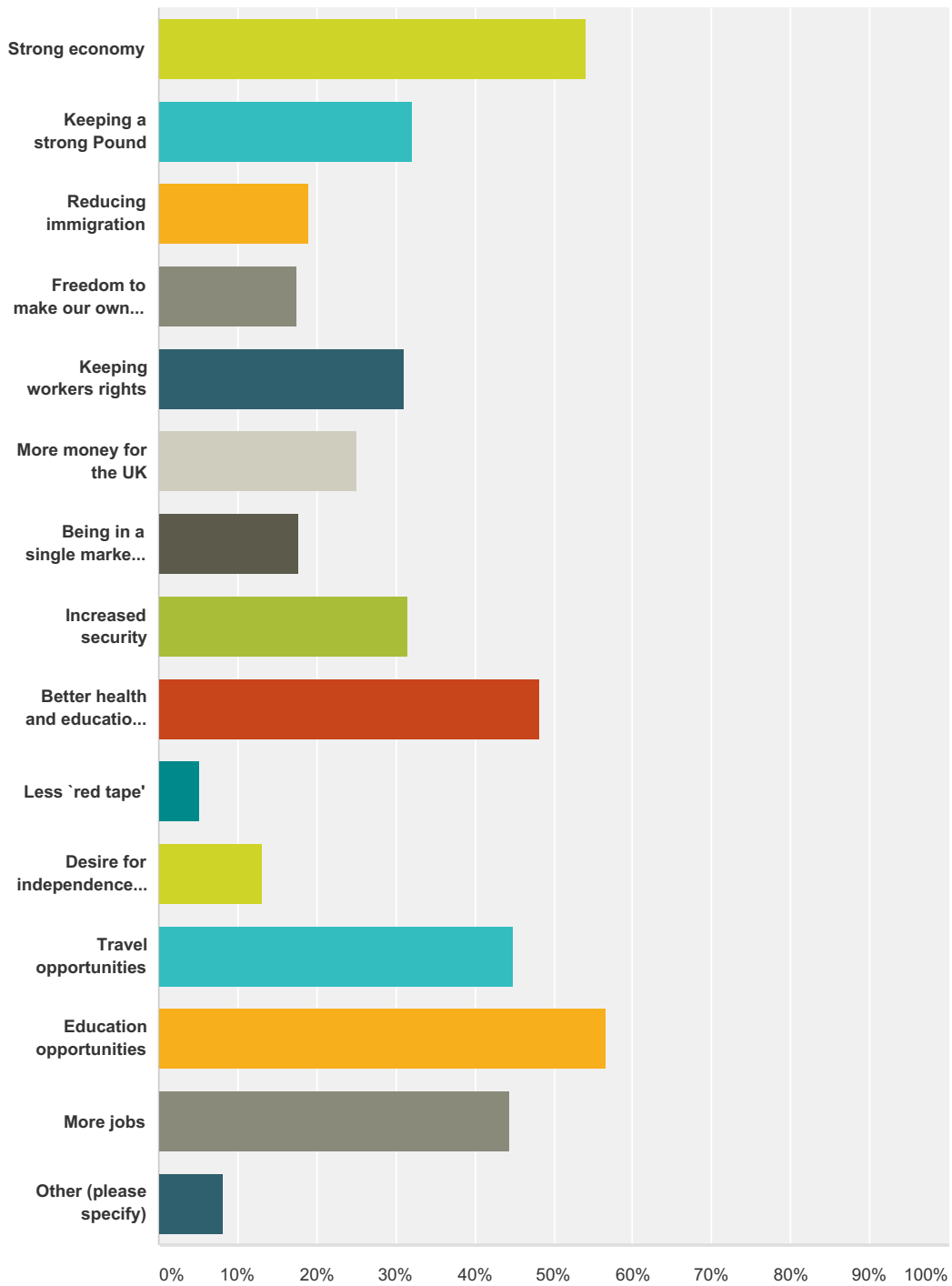

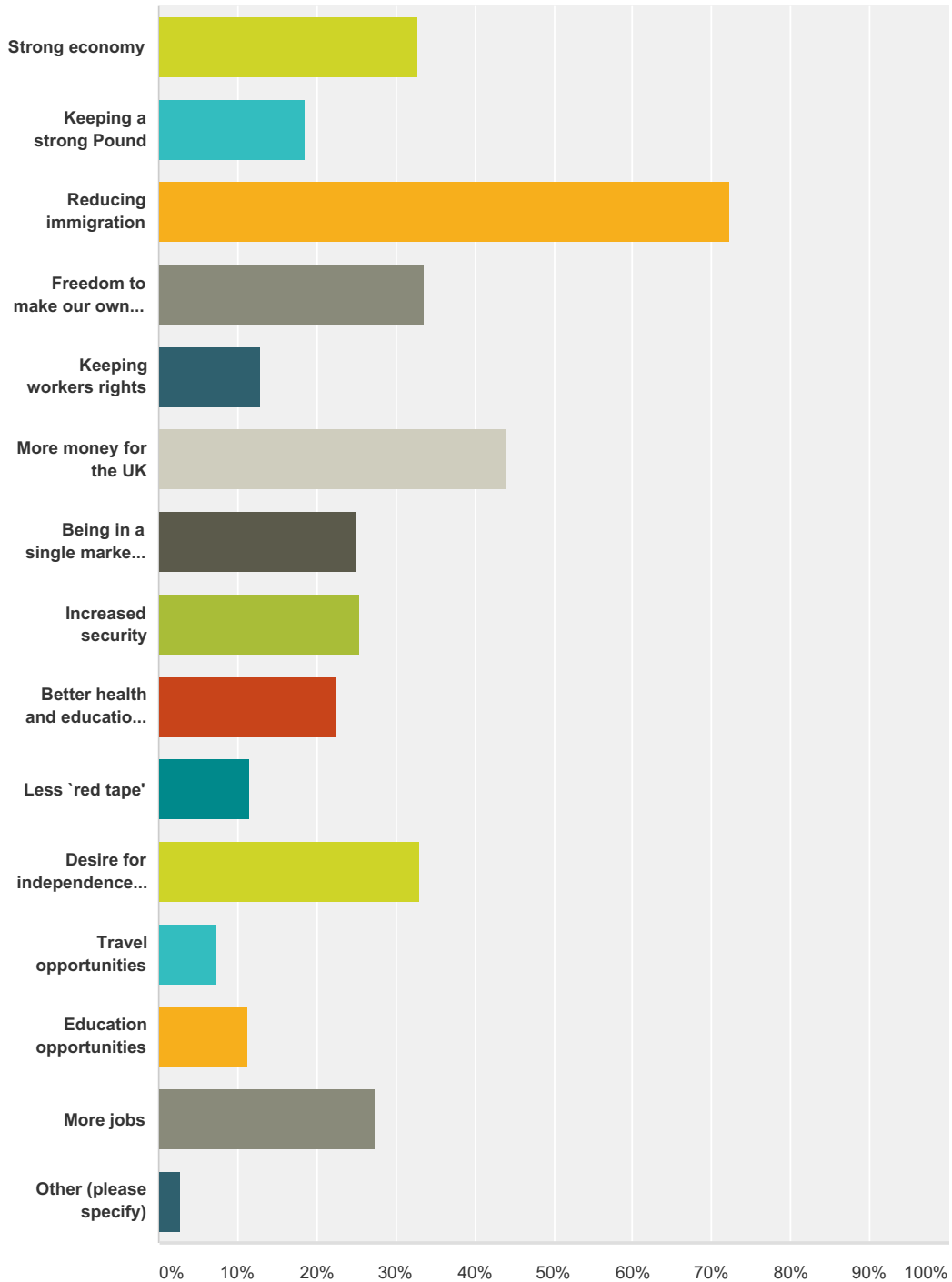

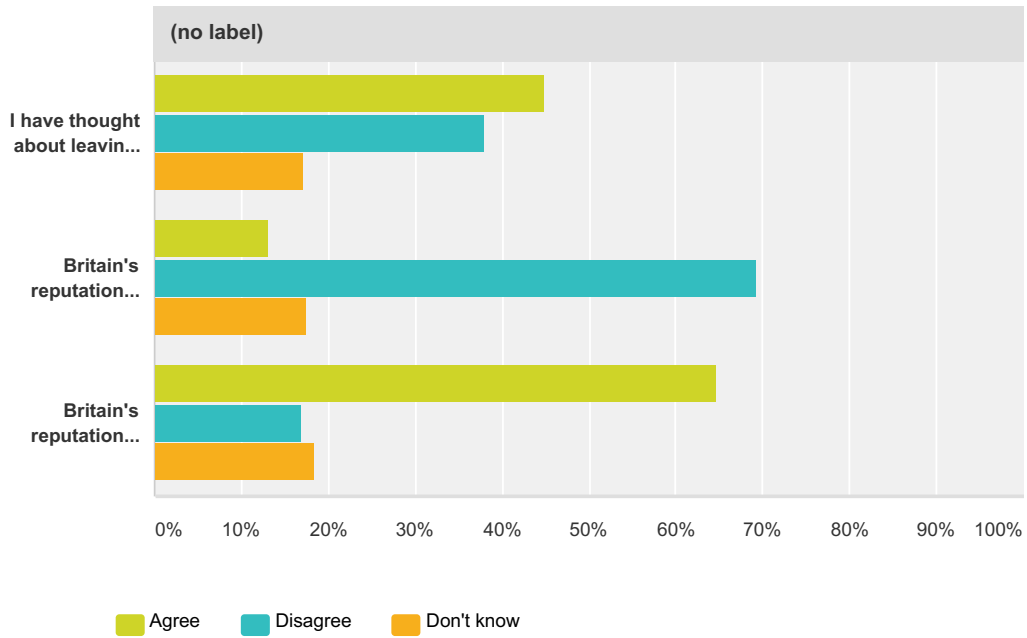

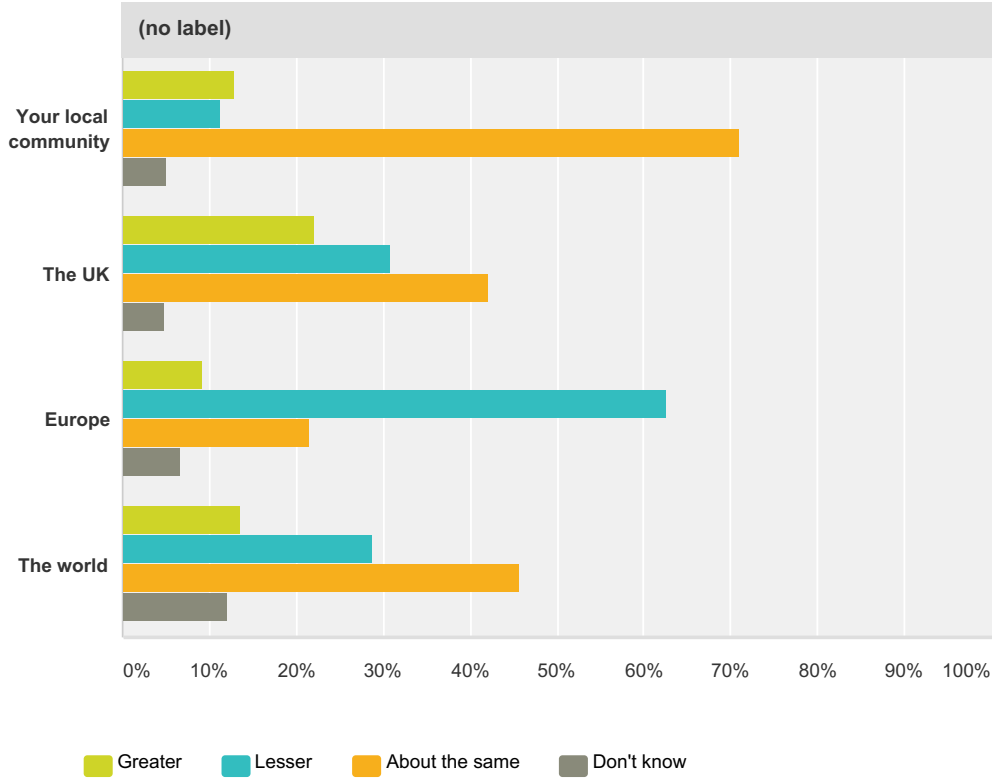

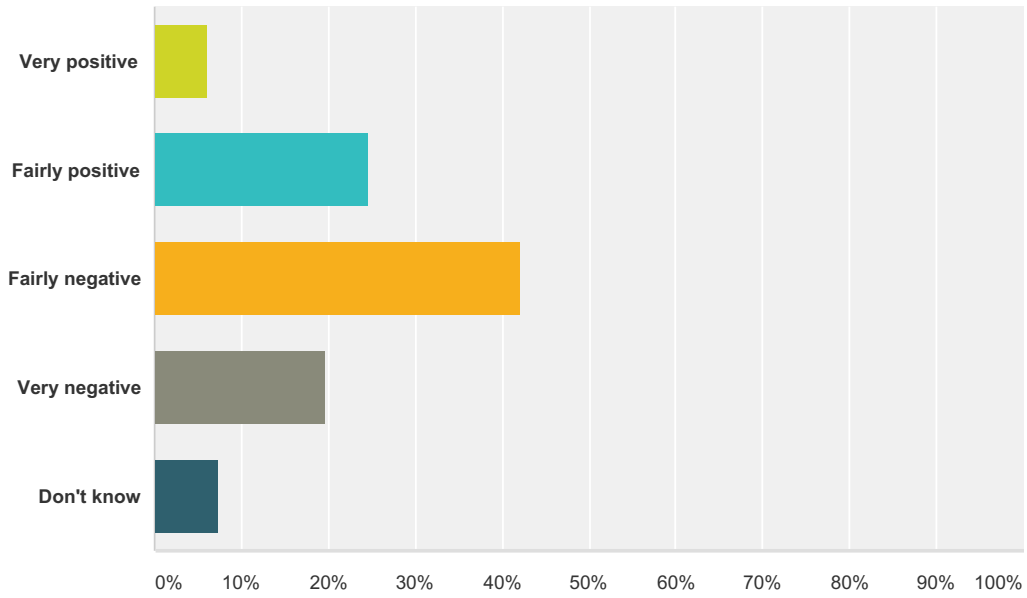

Q8 How positive or negative do you feel about Britain's future after the referendum?

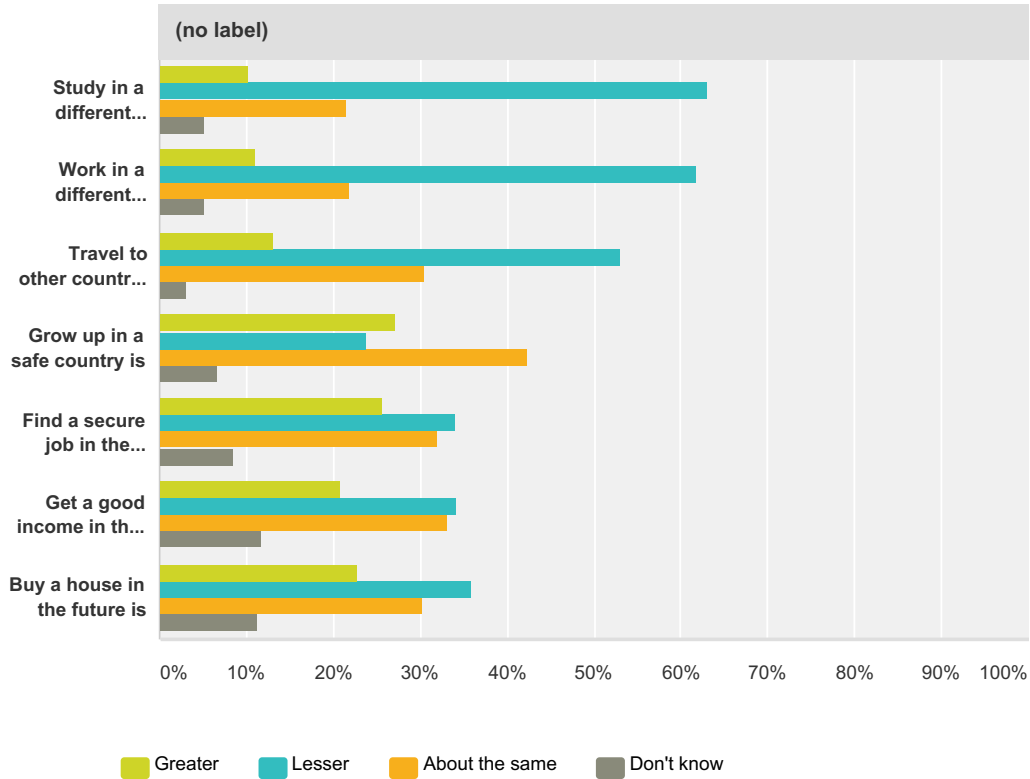

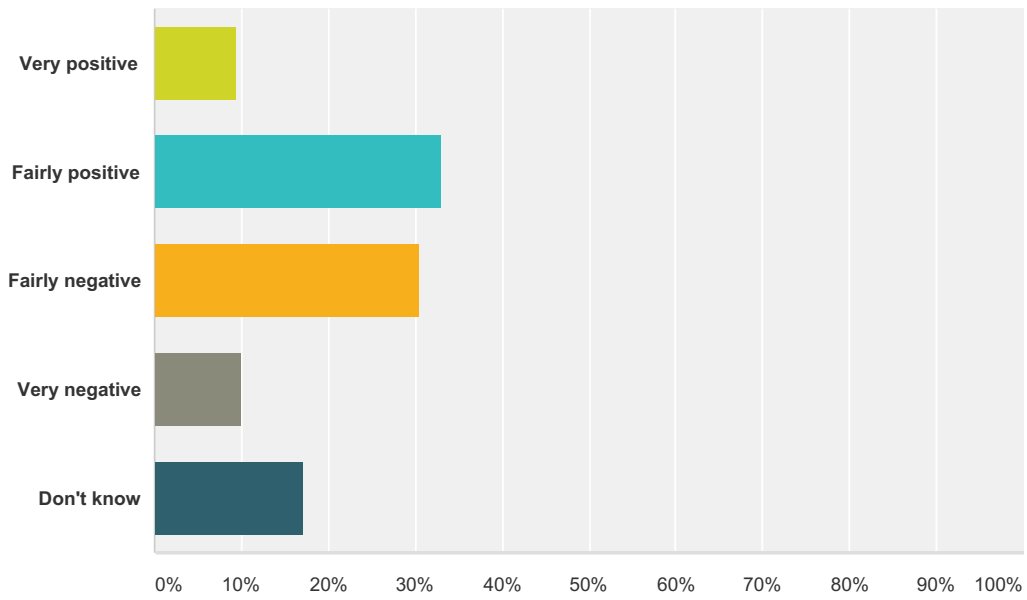

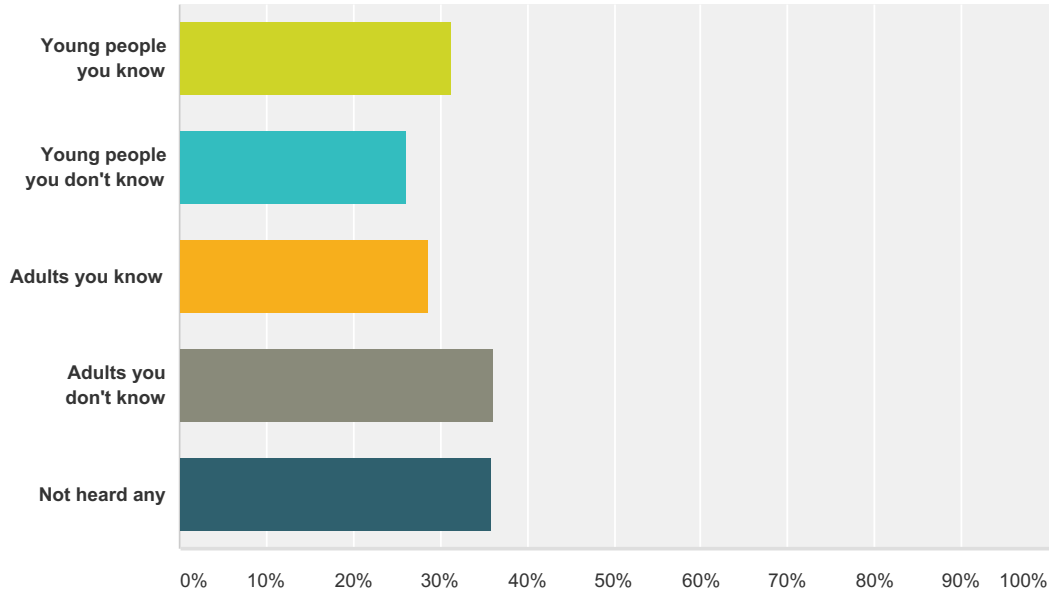

Q11 Have you or anyone you know, heard hateful comments since the referendum from...?

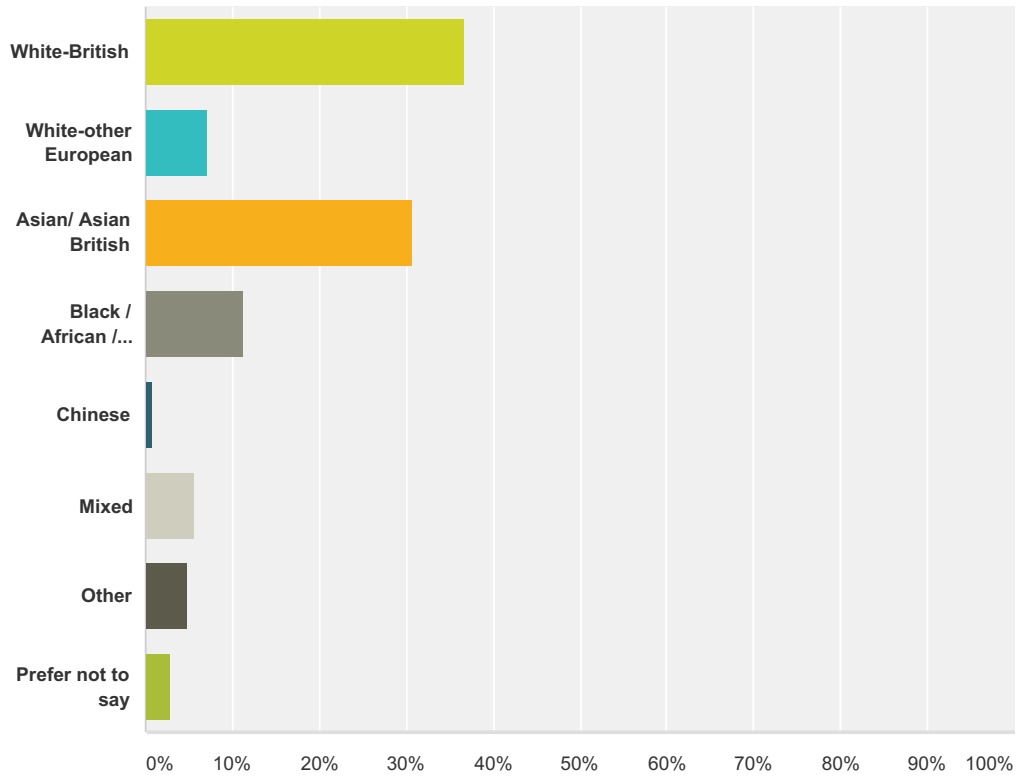

Q12 What ethnic group are you from?

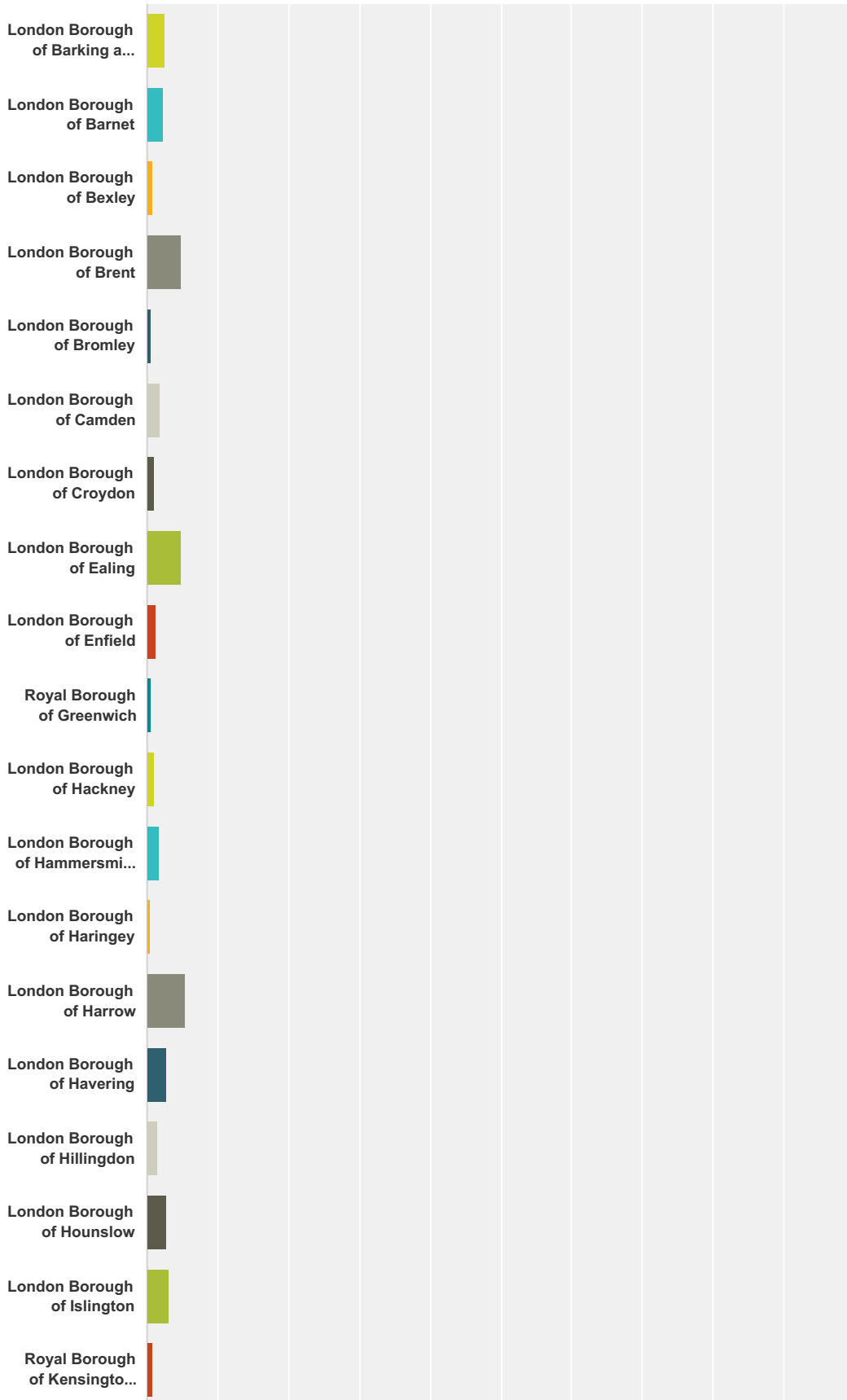

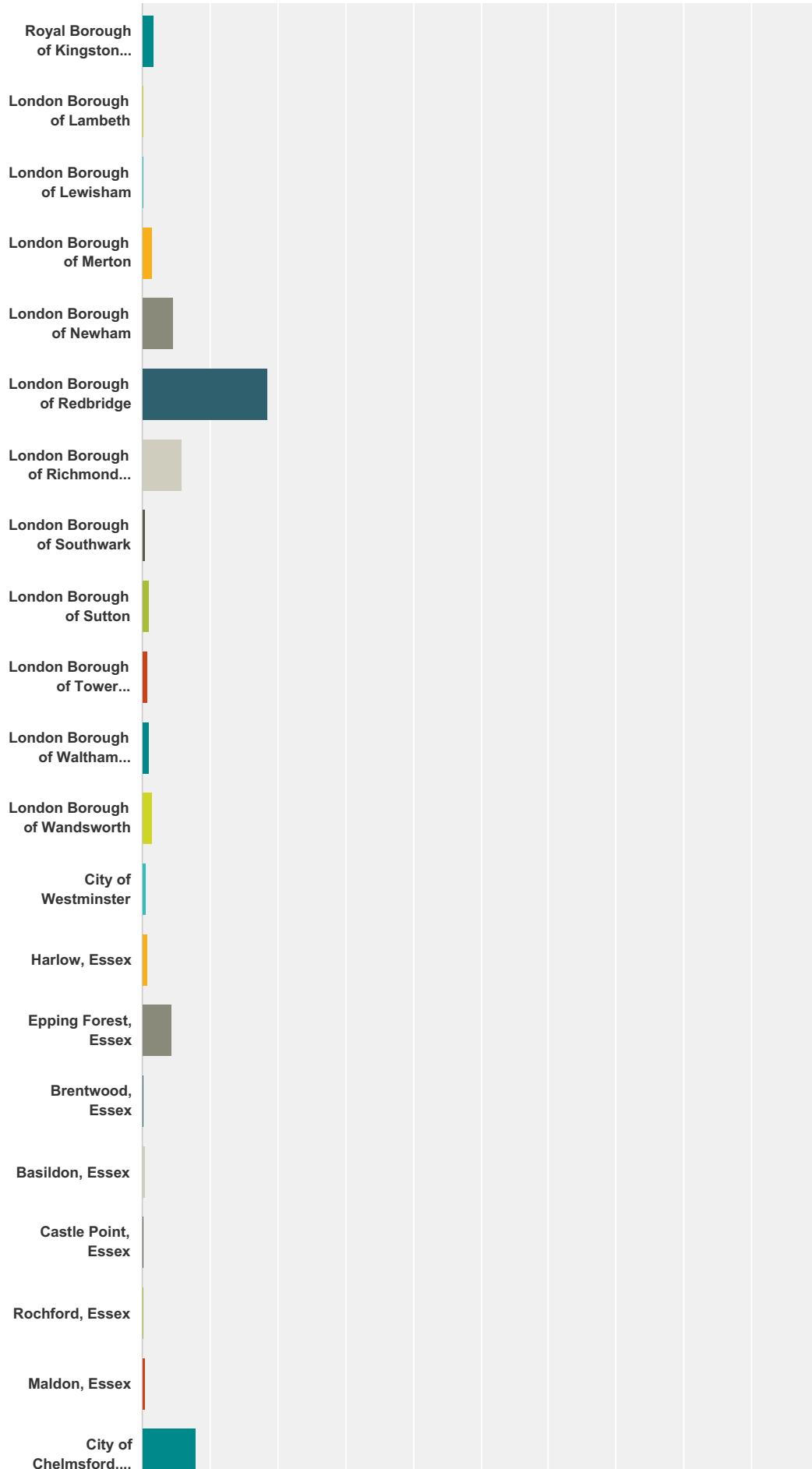

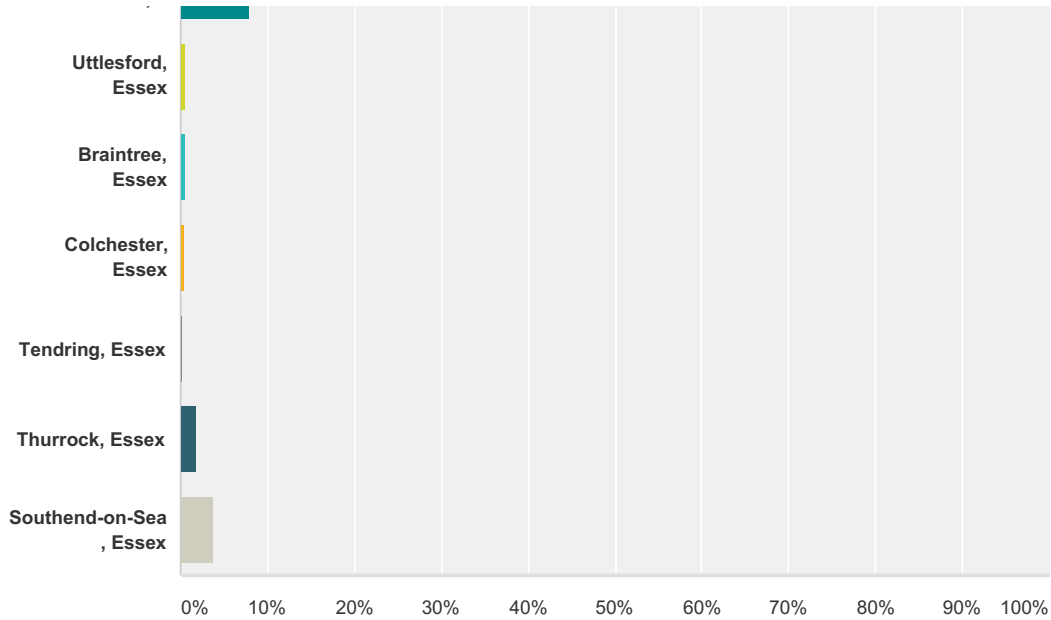
