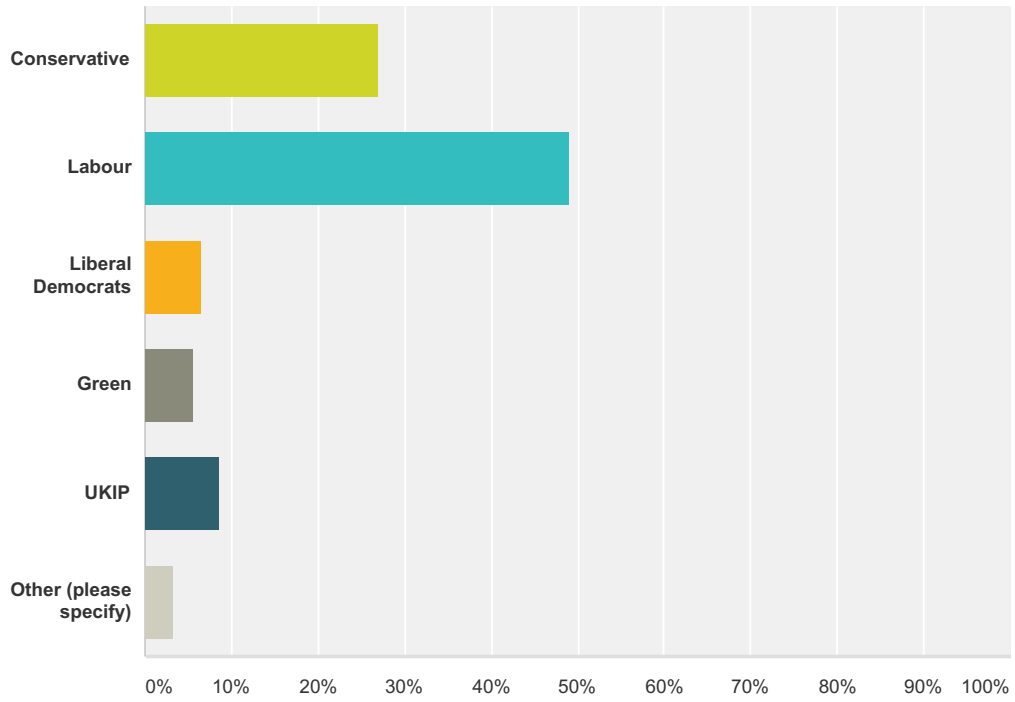

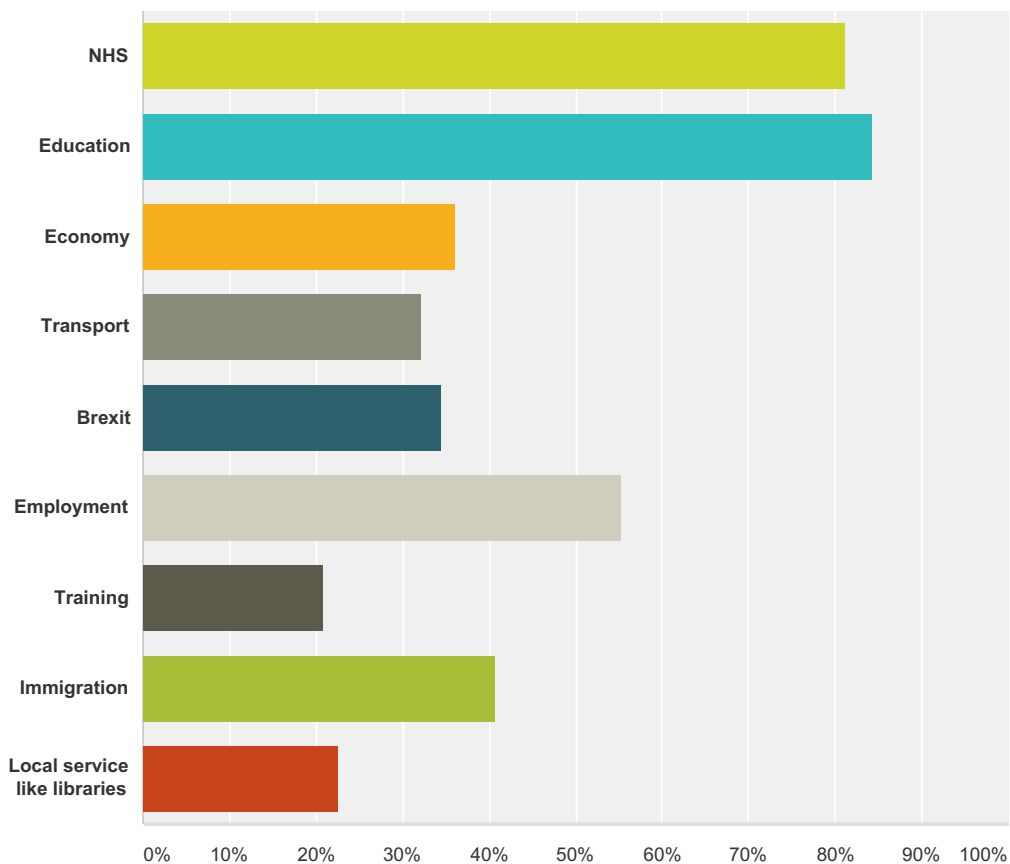

Q7 Which issues are most important to you? (click as many as you want)

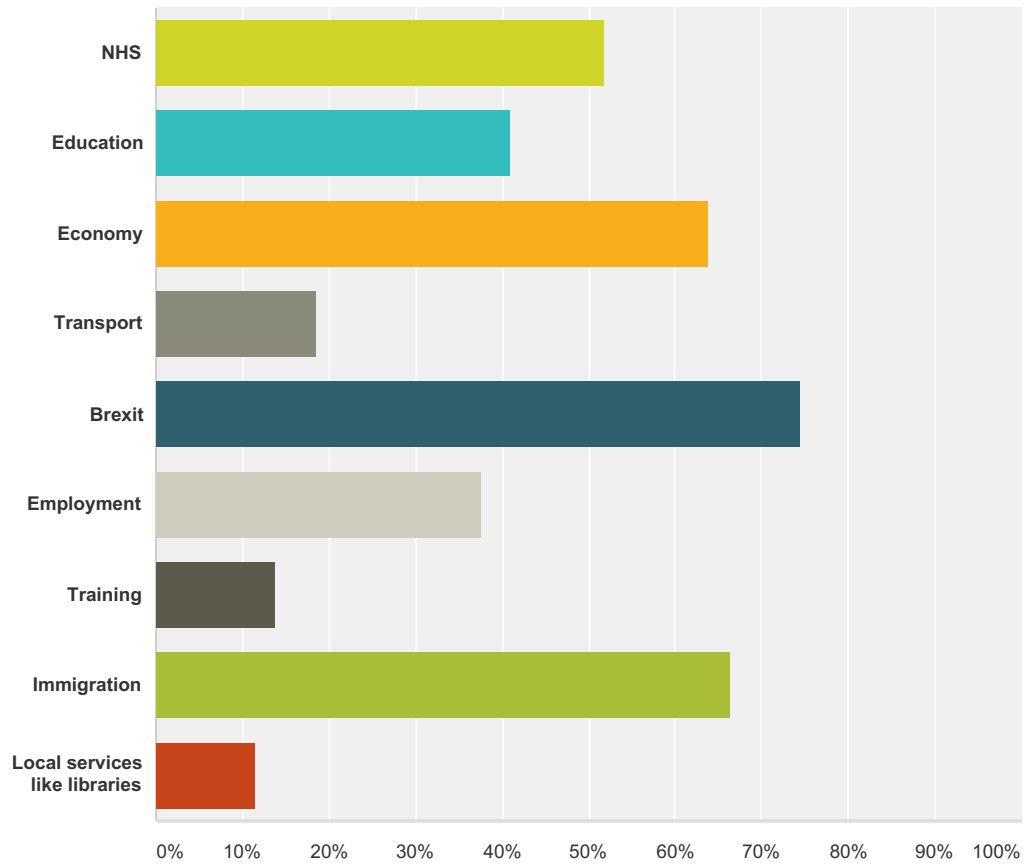

Q8 Which issues do you think are most important to politicians? (click as many as you want)

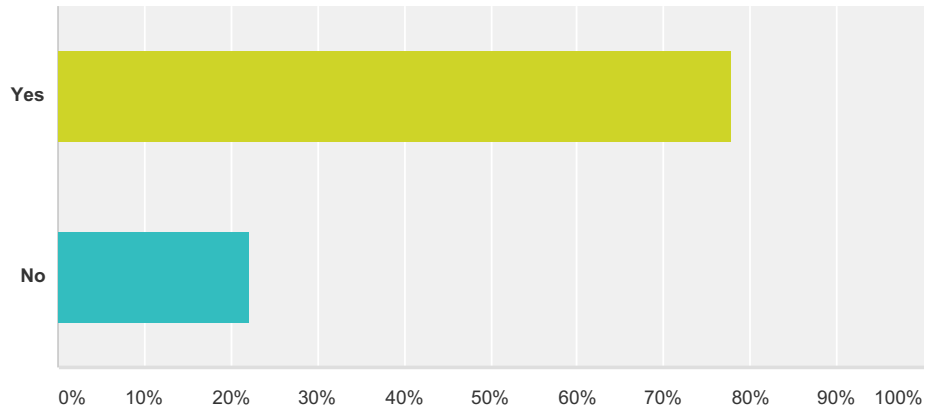
