Educational Visit Grant





The Jack Petchey Foundation recognises that educational visits provide young people with a unique learning experience, and help develop personal and social skills.

Organisations* running our Achievement Award Scheme can apply for two Educational Visit Grants per scheme per calendar year, each to a maximum value of £1,200. Grants are made to cover the entrance fees and/or transport costs. We

will fund to a maximum of £20 per young person, unless you are a SEND organisation, PRU or Special Education Provision in which case we will consider a higher per person limit.

SEND organisations/schools, Pupil Referral Units and Alternative Education Provisions can apply for up to £60 per person for day trips and up to £100 per person for residentials. If you are a SEND school/organisation, Pupil Referral Unit or Alternative Education Provision we will consider staff costs, for one member of staff, up to the value of £60pp for a day trip or £100pp for a residential. We may by exception consider a contribution towards costs for more than one member of staff. If you would like us to consider this, please contact your Grants Officer for advice before you apply.
