To help spark even more creativity, here are some inspiring ideas for your young environmental champions!



Examples:

1. School & Community Projects

- **Eco-Workshops or Exhibitions:** Host sessions on sustainability, climate change, or biodiversity.
- **Guest Speakers:** Invite local environmentalists or activists to speak at school events.
- **Creative Upcycling Projects:** Sewing clubs, thrift flips, or art made from reused materials.

2. Gardening & Growing


- **Vegetable Growing in Local Gardens:** Start a small edible garden or planter project.
- **Composting Workshops:** Teach students how to compost food and garden waste.

3. Outdoor & Nature-Based Activities

- **Bird Watching or Bat Walks:** Organised nature walks to observe local wildlife.
- **City Farm Visits:** Educational trips to learn about sustainable farming and animal care.
- **Rewilding Projects:** Seed bomb making, planting wildflowers, or revitalising green spaces.

4. Environmental Action Projects

- **Eco-Brick Project:** Fill plastic bottles with non-recyclable waste to create building blocks.
- **Recycled Art Competition:** Create sculptures or installations from waste materials.
- **Graffiti Cleanup or Legal Clean Graffiti:** With proper permissions, beautify local areas.

5. Partnerships & Collaborations

- **Projects with Bertha Earth or Similar Orgs:** Co-create environmental initiatives.
- **Visits to Environmental Plants:** Tours of recycling or water treatment facilities.

6. Nature-Based Learning & Conservation

- **Eco-Art & Fire Lighting Workshops**
- **Conservation Tasks & Ecological Surveys:** Hands-on activities to protect local habitats and build environmental skills.
- **Forest School Sessions:** Child-led outdoor learning experiences in natural settings.
- **Pollinator Garden:** Buy native plants, soil, and compost to create a bee/butterfly-friendly garden.
- **Bird Boxes & Bug Hotels:** Build or buy materials to create habitats for birds, insects, and hedgehogs.

7. Community Engagement Projects

- **Community Garden Start-Up Kits:** Tools and seeds for creating or enhancing local green spaces.
- **Plastic Reduction Campaigns:** Youth-led initiatives to reduce single-use plastics in schools or community centres.

8. Active Environmental Citizenship

- **Green Influencer Projects:** Support young people in designing and leading their own eco-projects.
- **Local Litter Picks or River Cleanups**

9. Eco Art Installation

- Use recycled materials to create an environmental-themed art piece.
- Display it in a public space to raise awareness.
